In March of 2017, the Oregon City School Board passed a resolution that affirms the district’s commitment to creating safe and welcoming school environments for all students.

In basic terms, the resolution says that everyone is welcome in our schools regardless of race, gender identity, sexuality, immigration status, country of origin or other factors. It also says that everyone is entitled to academic success regardless of their background or family circumstances and each student will be provided the necessary supports to ensure that success.

Oregon City Schools will continue to be, a place where students and their families can focus on learning without fear of discrimination or harassment. We have communicated this message with the leadership, staff, and students in our schools, but more remains to be done. Through communication and training, we can ensure that everyone in our schools knows how to be sensitive to their colleagues, students, and families.

Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying and Cyberbullying

Policies [JF, JFA, AC, JFCF]

Hazing, harassment, sexual harassment, bullying, cyberbullying, intimidation, menacing will not be tolerated.

Investigation by Local Law Enforcement

Policy [KN]

Police or government officials cannot take a student from school without a court order or permission from the parent or guardian.

Immigration Officials and Other Non-Local Law Enforcement

Policies [JOA, JOB, KN]

Officials can't remove a student from school without a warrant. Student records are confidential.

Complaints and Resolution Process

Policy [KL, KL-AR]

If complaint not resolved through the informal process, a formal complaint can be filed.
